Winney Hill Accident on Black Ice

Hob Lane was closed on Tuesday 28 December by police after Alan and Hazel's car slid on black ice into the bank and rolled over down Winney Hill. They were trying to avoid pedestrians and another vehicle stuck side-on across the road near the bottom of the hill. Miraculously, and thanks to Alan's prompt action, everyone emerged unhurt, apart from bumps and bruises. Alan's car was towed away as a write-off. The police requested the assistance of the County Engineer from DCC Highways. Upon closer inspection it was clear that blocked drainage gulleys result in excess water onto the road surface where it deep freezes. A formal complaint was lodged there and then so that repair work will be scheduled.

In the meantime, that last steep and relatively sheltered section of Winney Hill remains a serious hazard, as excess moisture freezes on contact with the frozen road surface. This black spot needs to be approached from either direction with extreme caution.
