Kirk Ireton Parish Council

Councillors

There should be six elected councillors although at present there are four, who were elected in May 2015 unopposed. They meet on the first Wednesday every month, except for August.

The Parish Council own:

- The Village Hall.
- The Open Space/ children's play area
- Buxton Hall car park.
- The defibrillator sited in the old telephone box on the Main Street.
- The notice board by Buxton Hall car park.
- We are also responsible for the Village Field which is held in trust and which we sub-let to the School through license.

The main Parish Council Income

- £9,000 – The 'Precept' which is approx 2.5% of the Council Tax paid from parish households.
- £4,170 – DDDC grant
- £2,600 (approx) – Hire of the Village Hall, for private functions and to the school.
- £1,285 – Hire of the Village Field to the School.

Parish Council Spending:

- Grass cutting on the Village Field, Open Space, the two greens and verges within the village.
- Insurance & Tax
- Maintenance of the Village Hall including heating oil and electricity. (The Village Hall is largely self sufficient although the Parish Council is responsible for any big repairs.)
- Maintenance and inspections of other assets including the Open Space play equipment and the tennis court on the Village Field.
- Administration and wage costs for the clerk.

The Parish Council discuss:

- Village Hall, Village Field, Open Space, footpaths and highways- including potholes.
- Planning applications within the parish.
- Budgets
- All other matters which affect the village.
